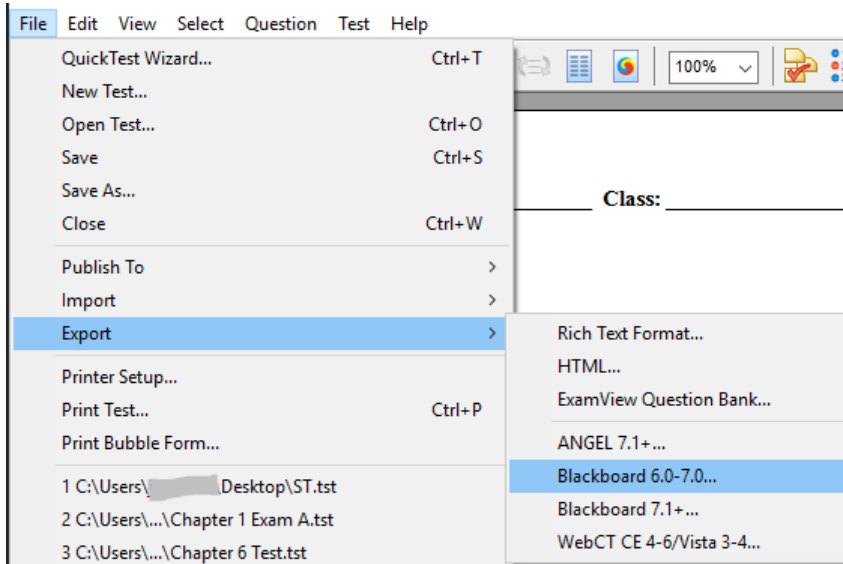
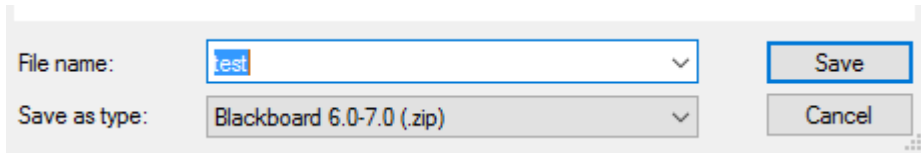


Import ExamView Tests into Moodle

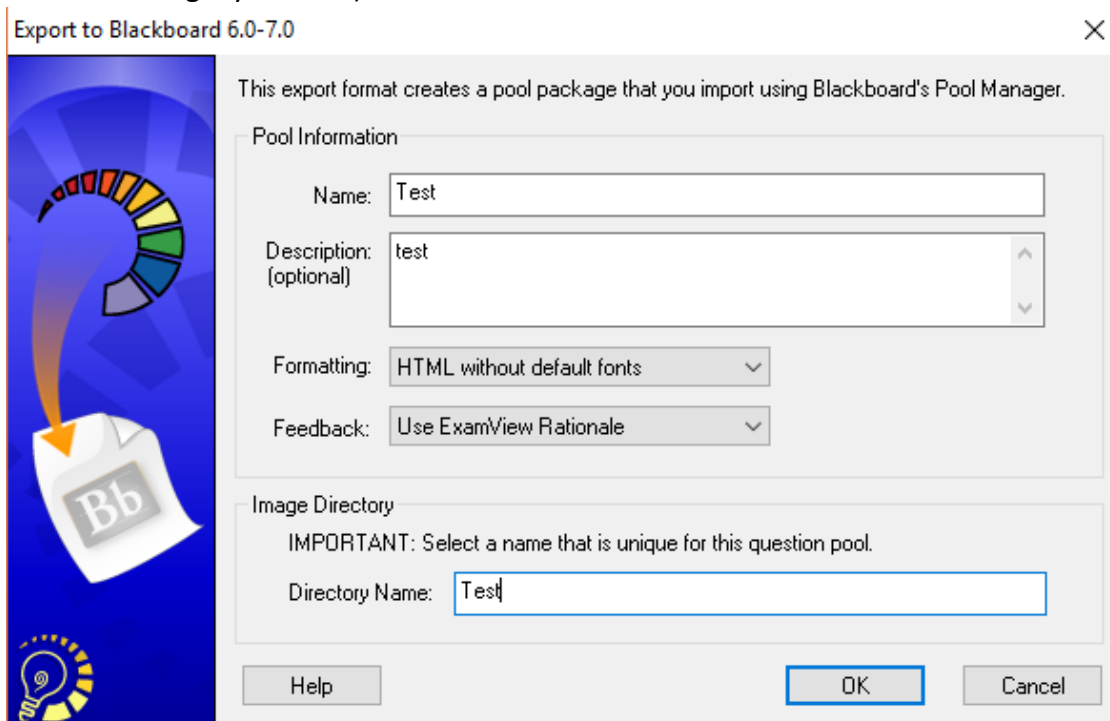
1. Open your test in **ExamView**
2. Click File → Export → and choose **Blackboard 6.0-7.0**



3. Name your test and save it in your H drive

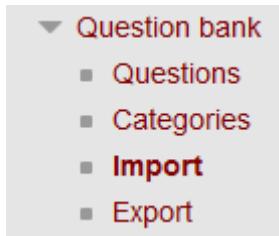


4. Next you'll have to enter in text for each of the fields Name, Description and Directory Name (they can all be the same thing if you want) Click **Next**



5. Login to Moodle and open your course.

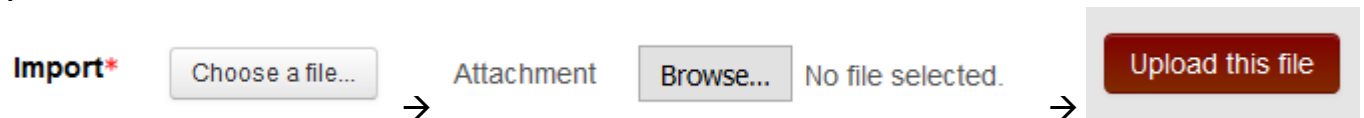
6. Under **Course Administration**, expand **Question Bank** and click **Import**



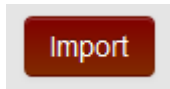
7. Under **File Format**, select **Blackboard**

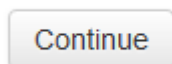
8. Under **Import Questions from File**, choose **Browse** and browse for your test file (.zip) to upload, then click **Upload this File**.



9. Click **Import**



10. The next screen will show you a preview of your questions. Some formatting on the questions might not look right on this screen, but that is normal. Scroll to the bottom and click **Continue**



11. The questions are now imported into your question bank.

12. Now it's time to create your quiz in Moodle. Or if you already have a blank quiz created in Moodle, you can go in and add questions from your question bank. From your question bank you can select a few or all questions from the ExamView test you just imported into Moodle.
